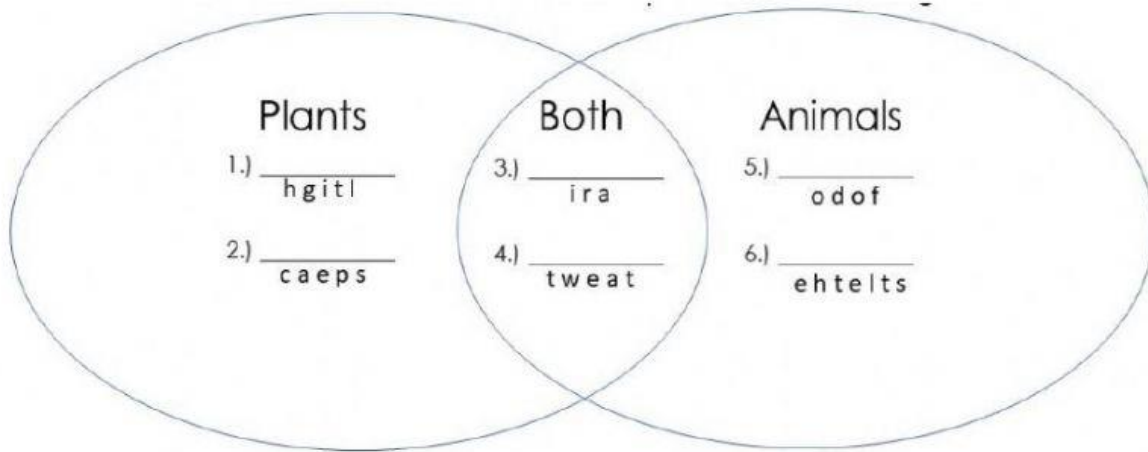

Woodland



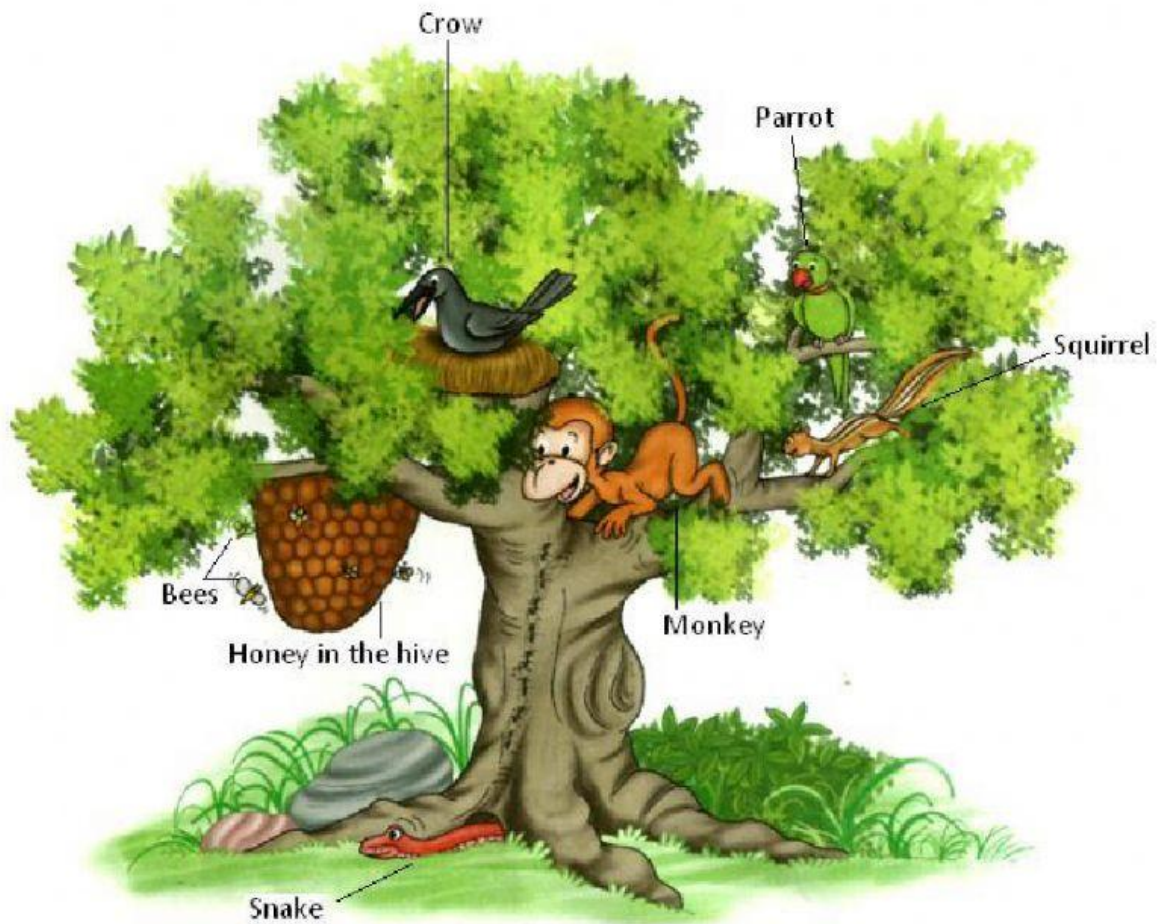
