$$18 + 9 + 6 = 33 \quad \text{or} \quad 18 - 9 - 6 = 3$$

You see 7 big trucks and some small trucks. There are 15 trucks in all. How many small cars are there?

$$15 - 7 = 8 \quad \text{or} \quad 7 + 15 = 22$$
