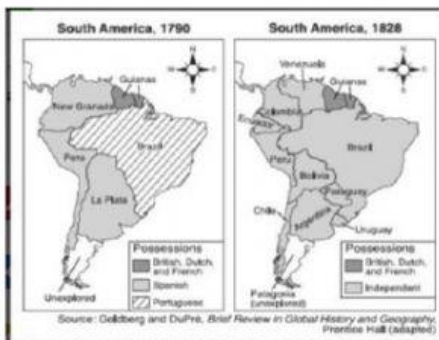

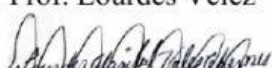
Petroleum was the single most important element in the Ecuadorian _____, accounting for over 14 percent of the GDP in 1986, two-thirds of all export **revenues** in that year, and much of the _____ **investment**. In 1987 petroleum and mining together accounted for only about 8 percent of GDP because of a significant drop in petroleum production, but estimates for 1988 indicated that petroleum _____ had risen, exceeding its 1986 level. Although Ecuador's level of production in the late 1980s ranked near the bottom of the thirteen members of OPEC, it exceeded all countries in Latin America except _____ and Venezuela.
