

Snakes are very interesting. Many people are afraid of snakes because of the way they move. Since they do not have legs, they move around by pushing their bodies. Although snakes look like they do not have bones, this is not true. The truth is that they have more bones than humans! That's why they can move so easily.

Snakes can live almost everywhere. They live on the ground, in trees and in water. But they cannot live in places where the ground is frozen. That's why there are no snakes in the Arctic or other cold areas. The snake's teeth are not stuck together, so it can open its mouth very wide. It can eat small animals that are bigger than its head! Most snakes cannot see very well. And although they have noses, they do not use them to smell. Instead, they smell with their tongues! They also have a small hole in their mouths so they can stick their tongue out without opening their mouths.

Probably the most interesting thing about snakes is how they eat. First of all, snakes only eat animals or animals' eggs. Although they have teeth, they do not use them to chew. The animal they eat goes into their throat and then into their body. It takes weeks or months for them to eat this animal. Some snakes only eat a couple of times a year! Finally, in the past, many people believed that snakes brought us good luck. In Greece, people believed that snakes could cure sick people. In Australia, people believed that a snake created the world. So you see, there are many strange facts about snakes. Are they good or bad? It's up to you to decide.


