

Unit 2. Leave-taking (Berpisah)

Leave-taking, dalam bahasa Indonesia berarti berpisah, digunakan untuk basa-basi pada waktu berpisah. Berikut ini beberapa cara penggunaan *leave-taking* beserta cara meresponsnya.
