



## **SIMILARITY**

We can use **as ... (adjective) as** to say that two things are the same, or not as ... as to say that one thing is less than another:

Example: Alice is **as** tall **as** Valery

We can use **not as ... (adjective) as** to say that one thing is less than another:

**Example:** Maths isn't **as** interesting **as** Arts
