Verb	Make
Make	We use make when we talk about creating something. Julia made a delicious cake for her family. My friend is a fashion designer. She makes nice clothes. Can you make me a coffee?
Do	We use do when we talk about general activities, duties, jobs and leisure activities. John did his homework yesterday. My friend is very fit. He does a lot of exercise. We often use do with something, anything, nothing and everything: I didn't do anything yesterday. We are going to do something special for her birthday.
