

<b>Animals see and hear</b>	<i>Ring- tailed lemurs, chameleon, direction, ghost green crab, tiny</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Chameleons:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Chameleons can move their eyes in a circle.</li><li>• Chameleons can see very well, better than us.</li><li>• Chameleons have tiny ears, they can't hear very well.</li></ul></li><li>- Ring-tailed lemurs:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ring-tailed lemurs'n tail have many rings.</li><li>• Ring-tailed lemurs have big eyes and sees very well.</li><li>• Ring-tailed lemurs have big ears and hears very well, too.</li></ul></li><li>- Ghost green crab:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ghost green crabs have green shell.</li><li>• Ghost green crabs can see around itself, but not clearly.</li><li>• Ghost green crabs use tiny hairs on their bodies to feel the sound.</li></ul></li></ul>


