

SEAHORSES

Seahorses are very small fish. Their head looks like a tiny horse. There are around 36 seahorse species. Seahorses live in the ocean. They are carnivorous. They have got a tail. They haven't got shells. They haven't got legs and arms.



They can live 3 years. The smallest seahorses are 2 cm. The biggest seahorses are 35 cm. A baby seahorse is the size of an M&M (conquito edo lakasito tamainakoa).

TURTLES

Turtles are reptiles. There are about 250 species.

Turtles have got a shell that protects them. They have got a little tail and they have got four legs. Turtles are herbivorous (they don't eat meat – ez dute haragirik jaten).

The smallest turtles are less than 10cm and the largest turtle is the leatherback sea turtle, it can weigh 900kg and it's 2 meters long! It's very very big.
