

				<b>UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nouns you <b>can't</b> count</li> <li>Normally, you can't use a / an in front of uncountable nouns</li> <li>We can make uncountable nouns countable to express quantity. We add a unit or a quantity with "OF"</li> <li>E.g. a <b>bar</b> of chocolate</li> </ul>
