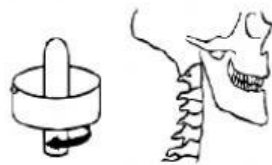

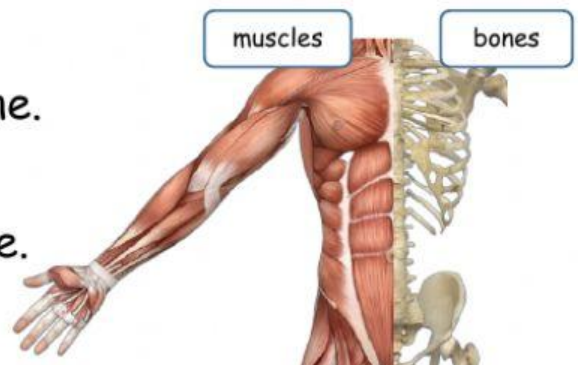

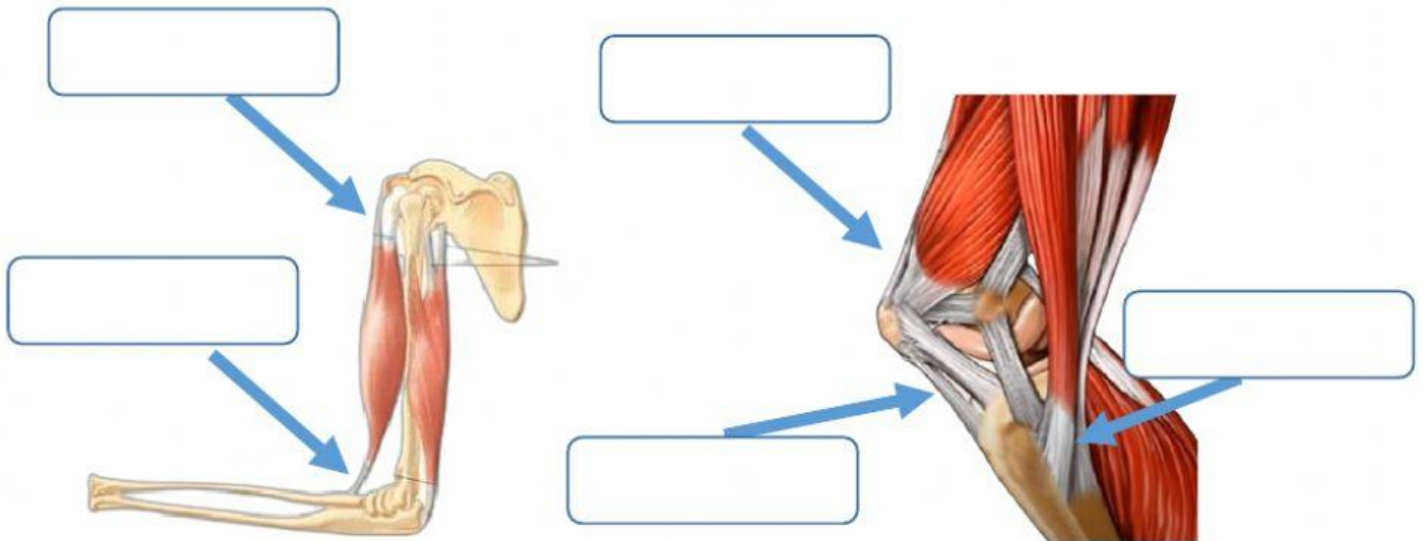

Protect , support and movement

- Skeleton is a **frame** for other parts of the body to attach to.



- Skeleton helps us **move**. We move at the points where our bones **joint together**. These are called **joints**.
