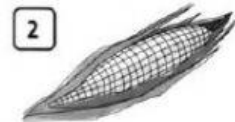

## II. Reading

### Dinosaur data

Dinosaurs lived on Earth for million years ago. Scientists study dinosaur bones to find out how they lived and what they looked like. There are more than 700 different kinds of dinosaurs! Some dinosaurs ate plants and others ate meat. Some walked on two legs and others walked on four legs. Some could fly and others lived in the sea. We know they were all different but no one know what color and pattern they were. This is because there's no dinosaur skin left to study. Dinosaurs disappeared 65 million years ago. Why was this? Some scientists think that a large rock called astan period fell to Earth from space. This made the Earth much colder and there was no longer any food for the dinosaur to eat. The most well-known dinosaur was T.Rex (Tyrannosaurus Rex). It was very fierce and it likes to fight and eat the flesh of another dinosaur. All the other dinosaurs were afraid of it. It was 14 meters long and 5.5 m high: bigger than a house. Its strong tail helped it move quickly. But no one knows how fast it can run. Its teeth were 36 centimeters long. The biggest dinosaur was Diplodocus. It was the biggest and tallest dinosaur. It was taller than a tree but it was not very fierce because it was the ethe ats plant. There are no dinosaurs today but you can see dinosaurs skeletons in some natural history museums.\

**III. Eating in China.**

Chinese food is delicious. They eat a lot of rice, noodles, vegetables, and meat. They fry or steam a lot of food, it's very healthy.

In China, people don't usually eat knives and forks. Instead, they use chopsticks and sometimes use spoons. They usually eat from big serving dishes. They put them in the middle of the table, but they sometimes serve portions of rice in small bowls. In China, they don't think it's rude to reach across the table to take food from serving dishes. They do think it is rude to take the last piece of food from a serving dish for yourself. They offer it to another person instead. That is very polite. When your bowl is empty, someone gives you





more food. When you are full, you put your hand over your bowl or leave some food in your bowl. They don't put chopsticks on top of their bowls. They put them on the table next to them when they finish eating. They don't use napkins, but they usually clean their hands with hot towels at the end of the meal.
