The Monument to Perished Soldiers

The square gained its name due to a glorious Monument to Perished Soldiers.1 _____ The Monument to Perished Soldiers was erected in 1975. It was designed by the sculptor V.I. Nechuy-Viter and the architect M.T. Nazarenko.

There are some granite memorial plaques at the bottom. The names of people who gave their lives for the freedom of Baranivka during the Great Patriotic War are written on them. The eternal fire reminds people about the terrible years of the war and teaches them
