THE GOLD RUSH IN AUSTRALIA

Early in 1851, Edward Hargraves discovered gold at Ophir near Bathurst in New South Wales. Many people rushed to New South Wales to search for gold.

In Victoria, where the population was half that of New South Wales, both the government and business people became worried by the move of population to the diggings in New South Wales. Some Melbourne businessmen offered a reward to anyone who might discover gold in Victoria.

In July 1851, gold was discovered at Clunes in Victoria and a month later a rich goldfield was discovered at Ballarat. Ballarat became one of the richest goldfields in Australia and brought people from all over the world to look for gold.

Within three years of the discovery of the goldfields, Victoria's population had exceeded that of New South Wales.
