Sample 1 : Words which appear in the Environment Science Textbooks

1. deer- 'de' as in deep and 'er' as in arithmetic
2. beast- 'be' as in bee and 'ast' as in east
3. environment- enviment ('r' and 'n' to be silent)
4. famine- 'fam' as in family 'ine' as in 'in'
5. drought- 'dro' as in drown 'ught' as in fought
6. vitamins- 'vi' as in village
7. Richter – ri-k-ter
8. hibiscus- 'hi' (as in hill) –bis-cus
9. flower- flaw-r
10. plateau- pla(as in plan) –toe
