1) Miguel is an American citizen with no criminal record. He sometimes posts on anti-government websites. When the local police chief hears that Miguel has a collection of over 50 firearms. He asks for paperwork indicating that the guns have been legally obtained. After Miguel provides it, he's ordered to turn the guns and ammunition over to the police.
