


Exam question

2015 \$ 40 million Spending quickly leveled off **smartphones**

The chart gives information about how much money was spent on computers and smartphones in country X between the years 2011 and 2015.

According to the chart, there were upward trends in on both items. Computer sales increased steadily by \$5 million each year. Smartphone sales at \$10 million until 2013 and then increased dramatically, reaching \$45 million dollars in . Although they are still less than the value of computer sales, they are only \$5 million behind.

People's total expenditure on these electronic devices rose dramatically in this period. The total was in 2011 and it rose to \$95 million in 2015.

Overall, the sales of both of these items grew, but smartphone sales grew more . If these trends continue, we can expect smartphone sales to overtake computer sales in 2016 or soon after.
