

Present Simple of Present Progressive - Negative

1. Present Simple

Subject	Verb	Examples
I, you, we, they	do not / don't + V1	I don't sing, they don't watch, you don't guess
He, she it	does not / doesn't + V1	She doesn't sing, he doesn't wash, it does not try

2. Present Progressive

Subject	Verb	Examples
I	am + not + V + ing	I am not singing, I'm not washing.
You, we, they	are + not + V + ing	You are not watching, we aren't trying.
He, she it	is + not V + ing	She is not talking, It isn't running.

If the verb ends with an "e", we delete the "e":

Make - I am not making dinner.

Take – She isn't taking this home.
