Read the words below. Pronounce the r sound correctly.

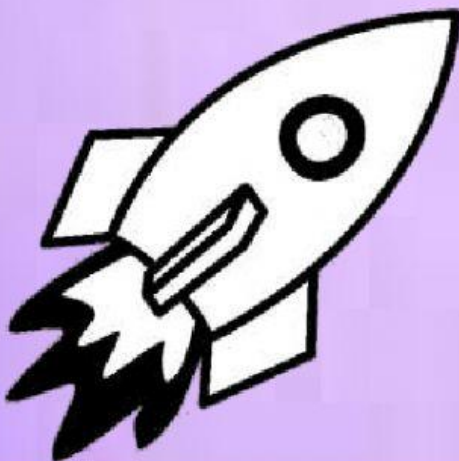
<u>r</u> at	far <u>r</u>

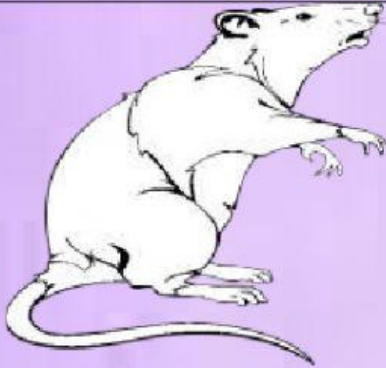
Rocket

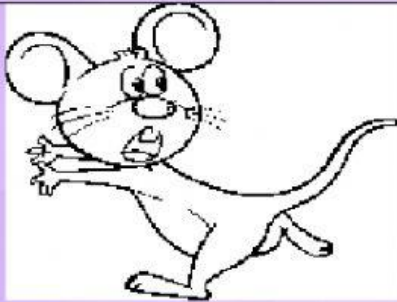

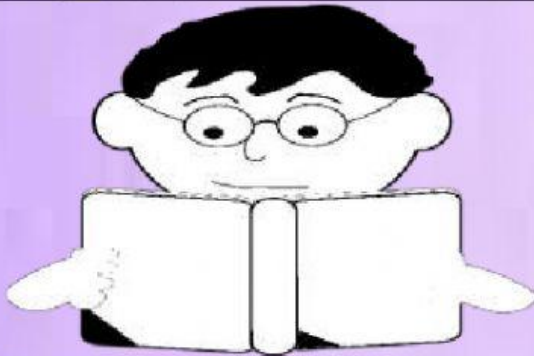

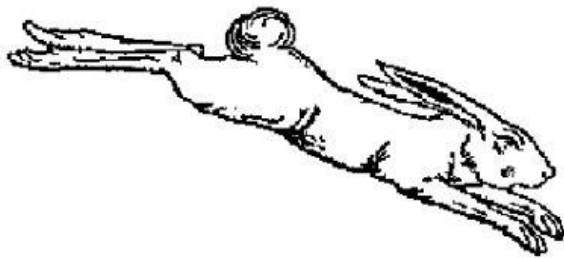
