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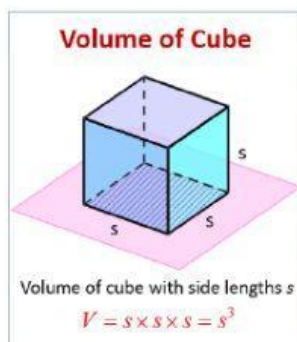

Finding Volume of Cube, Cuboid and Cylinder

(การหาปริมาตรของลูกบาศก์ ทรงลูกบาศก์ และทรงกระบอก)

Volume of a Cube:

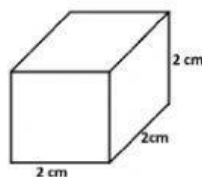
Volume = side x side x side = s^3



Example: Find the volume of the cube below:

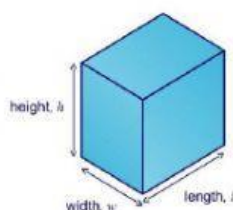
Solution:

$$\text{Volume} = 2 \text{ cm} \times 2 \text{ cm} \times 2 \text{ cm} = 8 \text{ cm}^3$$



Volume of a Cuboid:

Volume = length x width x height
 $V = L \times W \times H$



The area of the base
= length x width

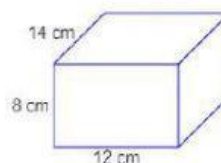
So,

Volume of a cuboid
= length x width x height
= lwh

Example: Find the volume of the cuboid below:

Solution:

$$\text{Volume} = 12 \text{ cm} \times 14 \text{ cm} \times 8 \text{ cm} = 1,344 \text{ cm}^3$$

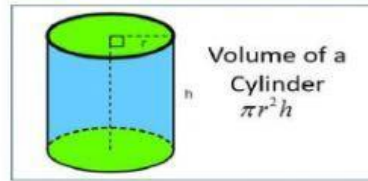


Volume of a Cylinder:

Volume = $\pi \times \text{radius}^2 \times \text{height}$

$$V = \pi \times r^2 \times h$$

where $\pi = 3.14$ or about $\frac{22}{7}$



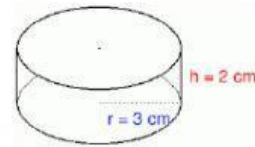
Example: Find the volume of the cylinder below:

Solution:

$$\text{Volume} = \pi \times r^2 \times h$$

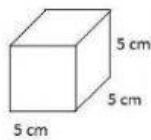
$$V = \pi \times (3 \text{ cm})^2 \times 2 \text{ cm}$$

$$V = 18\pi \text{ cm}^3 \text{ or } 18 \times 3.14 \text{ cm}^3 = 56.52 \text{ cm}^3$$
