

PRESENT CONTINUOUS (presente continuo)

(estar) **BE** + **VERB -ing** (-ando / -endo)
 (am / is / are) (reading)

Reglas para añadir **-ing** al verbo principal

Regla general (la mayoría de los verbos)	Añaden: -ing	wear ⇒ wearing drink ⇒ drinking play ⇒ playing
Los verbos terminados en: -e	Se quita la -e y se añade: -ing	dance ⇒ dancing have ⇒ having make ⇒ making
Los verbos terminados en: consonante + vocal + consonante	Doblan la última consonante y se añade: -ing	run ⇒ running sit ⇒ sitting swim ⇒ swimming

We **are not** eating (nosotros/-as no estamos comiendo)
You **are not** jumping (vosotros/-as no estais saltando)
They **are not** studying (ellos/-as no estan estudiando)

Short form

I'm **not** drinking
You **aren't** singing
He **isn't** dancing
She **isn't** running
It **isn't** playing
We **aren't** eating
You **aren't** jumping
They **aren't** studying

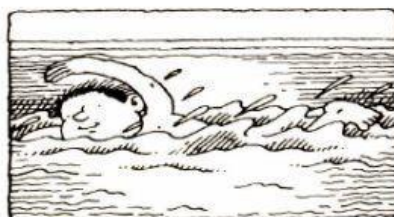

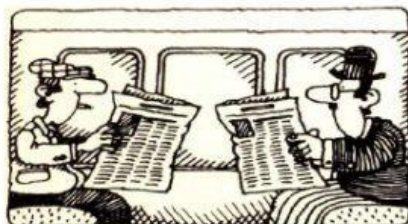
