* Forms: S + V-ed + O. S + didn't + V + O. Did + S + V + O? (S = I / You / We / They / He / She / It) Example: (+) They played football at the park yesterday. (-) They didn't play football at the park yesterday. (?) Did they play football at the park yesterday? * Signal words: <i>yesterday, last week, last month, last year, last....., ago, in 1998</i>	* Form: S + was / were + V-ing + O. S + wasn't / weren't + V-ing + O. Was / Were + S + V-ing + O? (S = I / He / She / It + was) (S = You / We / They + were) Example: (+) She was cooking dinner at 6 P.M. yesterday. (-) She wasn't cooking dinner at 6 P.M. yesterday. (?) Was she cooking dinner at 6 P.M. yesterday? * Signal words: <i>At..... (6.00 yesterday morning, when ...V(past) , While..... V-ing</i>
