

## Adverbs

An adverb describes a verb.

She walked **quickly**. He sang **loudly**. She sighed **sadly**.

Adverbs tell us **how** something happened. They can also tell us when and where things happen. She walked **outside**. He **often** sang. She **always** sighed. Watch these videos to find out more:
