SMART HOME

SMART THERMOSTAT

Many people live in very hot or very cold places. Their living conditions require year-round heating or cooling. Smart thermostats are used to reduce the costs of heating and cooling. These devices are able to know when a person is at home. They can then adjust the temperature based on the person's preferences. They will also turn off when no one is in the house. This might not seem like big energy savings. However, studies have found that smart thermostats reduce energy costs by about 20%.

SOLAR POWER

Solar power is created by the sun, which means it is free and renewable. In the past, using solar power wasn't very efficient. A solar panel cost more money than it saved. It also couldn't provide enough electricity for a full day. However, solar panels are now 70% cheaper than they were 10 years ago. This is why many homes are now installing solar panels. On average, a solar panel pays for itself in seven to eight years.

SMART WATER FAUCETS

Smart faucets work like automatic faucets you find in public restrooms. But smart faucets have new technologies to help you save water. Temperature settings can be adjusted based on what you're doing. Smart faucets also adjust the amount of water being used. This means they will change settings when you're cooking, cleaning, or washing your hands.
