

MUSIC GENRES (Match)

	Music for solo voice and voices in combination, with or without instrumental accompaniment.
	Music performed exclusively by musical instruments or musical objects.
	It is music purely for the sake of music. It is music that is not explicitly "about" anything.
	Music that represents extra-musical contexts that are not directly related to music.
	Music composed to be played in a religious context.
	Music composed for religious ceremonies, as part of the liturgy (f. i. a mass).
	Music of a religious character composed for religious purpose, but which is not part of the liturgy (f. i. a Christmas carol, a saeta...)
	Non-religious music.
	"Classical Music" or music that belong to a written tradition (implies advanced musical considerations)
	Music transmitted orally, music with unknown composers and usually performed by non-professional musicians.
	Music distributed to large audiences through the music industry and disseminated by the mass-media (f. i. jazz, rock, hip-hop, electronica...)
	Music composed for a purpose (ceremony, film, commercial, drama, theatre...)
