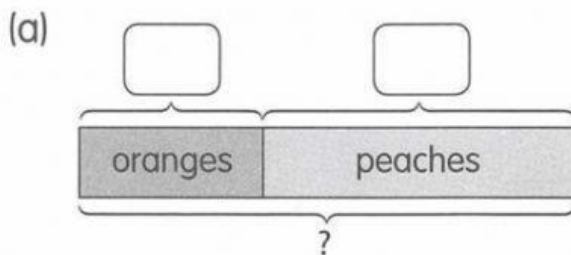

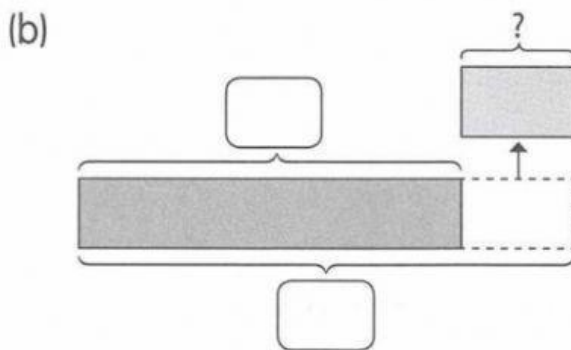
## Practice 1 Two-Step Word Problems

 (b) How many boxes of peaches did Uncle Sayid sell?

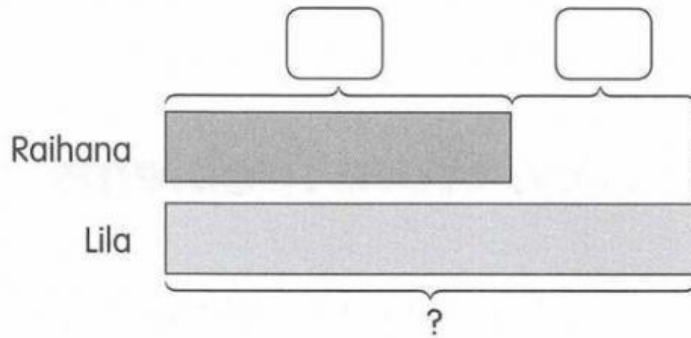


Uncle Sayid had \_\_\_\_\_ boxes of fruits at first.

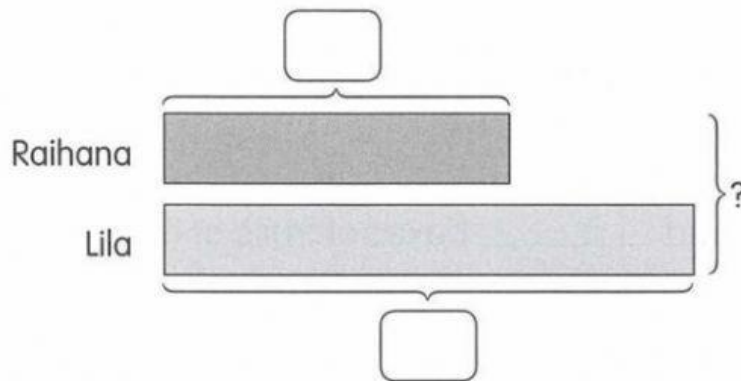


Uncle Sayid sold \_\_\_\_\_ boxes of peaches.
