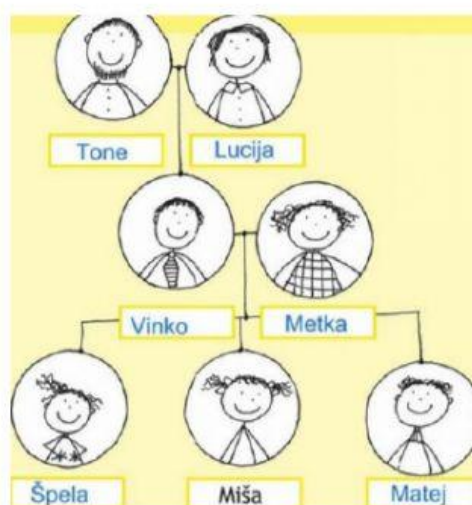

Sydney is a city in the southeast of Australia, on the Tasman Sea. It isn't the capital. Canberra is the capital, but 4.6 million people live in Sydney, and only 380,000 people live in Canberra.



Sydney is an amazing city, built on the hills round Sydney harbour (= luka). Thousands of people go there on holiday every year. If you want to visit the different parts of the city, you can travel by bus or train, or you can go by boat – there is a very good ferry service (= trajektna linija).

Perhaps you don't like big cities and you want to sit in the sun by the sea? No problem! There are 70 lovely beaches in Sydney. If you're good at surfing, go to Bondi beach. If you're feeling energetic, you can climb to the top of the Harbour Bridge. If you're interested in music, go to the famous Opera House. And if you're hungry, Australian food is fantastic.
