

Finding the Area




Area = length x height

Example:




Area = length x height
Area = 10×5
Area = 50m^2

Try these:




Compound shape = A shape made up of 2 shapes together

Example:



We can split the compound shape into 2 easier shapes




Shape A
Area = 5×4
Area = 20m^2

Shape B
Area = 10×5
Area = 50m^2

Total Area
Area = A + B
Area = $20 + 50$
Area = 70m^2


