Word Part	Meaning	Example
phon	sound	An earphone is something that goes in your ear to help you hear <i>sound</i> .
graph	write, recording	A graphic novel tells a story with words and drawings.
photo	light	A photograph is a drawing produced by <i>light</i> , with the help of a camera.
auto	self	An automobile is a <i>self</i> -propelled mobile, or vehicle. The car's engine makes it move.
tele	far	A telescope is a device that makes <i>faraway</i> objects look close.
