Prohibition in 1919, The Bahamas would again become the port-of-call for the wicked. Bahamian Rum became the export of choice to the mainland, where liquors were now illegal. Bootleggers set up camp among the Biminis, only 50 miles from Miami, as well as smaller operations throughout other islands and cays such as Gun Cay, West End and the Berry Islands. Inns and taverns sprung up to gain patronage from the criminal element. One famous hotel called the Lucerne Hotel, which became the meeting ground for both traders and criminal elements like the famous gangster called Al Capone. After prohibition ended in 1933 and the United States fell into a depression, the Bahamas returned to a life of subsistence agriculture and fishing.
