Example:

are – ear

care – race

god – dog

meat – team

note – tone

won – now

earth – heart

slip – lips

Anagrams are words or phrases created by rearranging the letters of another word or phrase. An anagram becomes an antigram when it is opposite in meaning to the original word or phrase.

Example:

santa – Satan

epitaphs – Happiest

united – untied

harmfulness – Harmless fun
