Simon and Peter are at a restaurant.

Peter: It's 1:30. It's early. **Do Americans usually have lunch at this time?**

Simon: One-thirty is late. Americans usually eat lunch around noon. Some have an hour for lunch, and others have thirty minutes. **Do you want to order a sandwich?**

Peter: Yes, I do. I'm hungry. Look. That man has a very big salad.

Simon: Yes, some people eat a salad for lunch.

Peter: **Do people eat salads instead of sandwiches?**

Simon: Yes, sometimes. Or they have a small sandwich with a small salad or cup of soup.

Peter: **Do Americans often eat in restaurants?**

Simon: Yes, they do. They're very busy. They don't always have time to cook every meal. Sometimes they go out to restaurants. Sometimes they order their food from restaurants.

Peter: **Do restaurants deliver food to your home?**

Simon: Yes, some do. And many restaurants have "takeout" food. They prepare the food for you. You take it home to eat. Supermarkets sell prepared food, too. Usually it's in the deli section. They have hot and cold food. Some supermarkets have tables, and people eat there. But most people take the prepared meals home. Prepared food is very popular because you don't have to cook.

Peter: **Does prepared food cost more?**

Simon: Yes, it does. But it's very convenient.

DID YOU KNOW?

61 percent of Americans eat at a restaurant at least once a week. 16 percent eat out three or more times a week, and 4 percent eat out more than three times a week.
