

Sonata

Concerto for one single soloist with orchestral accompaniment

Suite

Piece for one or more soloists with accompaniment on the harpsichord or cello

Concerto Grosso

composition of a single movement and in contrapuntal style (imitative counterpoint), usually with three or four voices

Concerto Solo

Concerto for many soloist and orchestral accompaniment.

Fuga

A mix of contrasting dances
