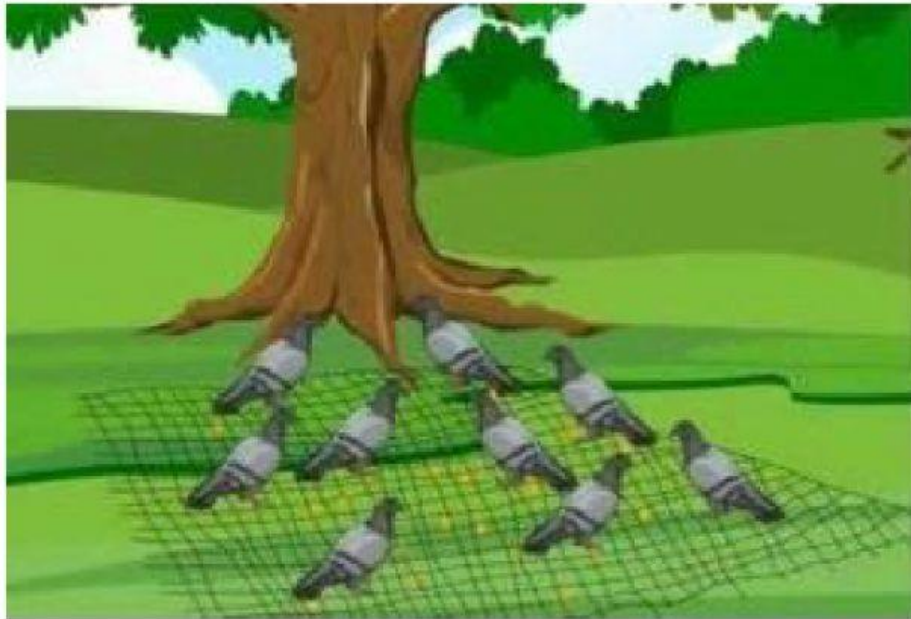


The Hunter and the Pigeons
