Adj with 1 syllable, add: 'the' + '-est' (or '-st')	cold "January is often the coldest winter month."	Adj ending in '-y', change '-y' to 'i' and add: 'the' + '-est'	happy "John is the happiest person I know."
Adj end in 'CVC', double the last letter and add: 'the' + '-est'	hot "August is often the hottest month."	Adj with 2(+) syllables, add: 'the most' + adjective	generous "My father is the most generous man."
