THE RISE OF THE ROMAN EMPIRE

Romulus and Remus developed into great men. As young men, Romulus and Remus were both skilled warriors and strong leaders. One day, their father, Mars, asked them to build a great city where the wolf rescued them. The brothers worked very hard for a number of years. Together, they started their own army, farmed the lands and constructed many



beautiful buildings. After that, the only thing to do was to give the city a name.

Each proud of their efforts, both Romulus and Remus wanted the name the city after themselves. After arguing about it, they were unable to agree on a name so the brothers decided to have a public sword fight. After killing his brother Remus, Romulus named the city 'Rome' in his own honour and became its first king.
