Be Going To

- **Be going to** also tells about the future. It is used for **future plans that are already arranged**.

Positive	Negative
He is going to study Chinese.	He isn't going to study Chinese.
Question	Answer
Is he going to study Chinese?	Yes, he is . No, he isn't .
Future plans / Intentions	<p>I'm going to visit my uncle this summer. (I've already planned it.)</p> <p>We are going to travel by train. (We already bought the train tickets.)</p>
Future predictions based on evidence in the present	<p>It is going to rain. (The sky is dark.)</p> <p>He's going to be late for the nine o'clock meeting. (It's almost nine o'clock now and he hasn't arrived yet.)</p>
