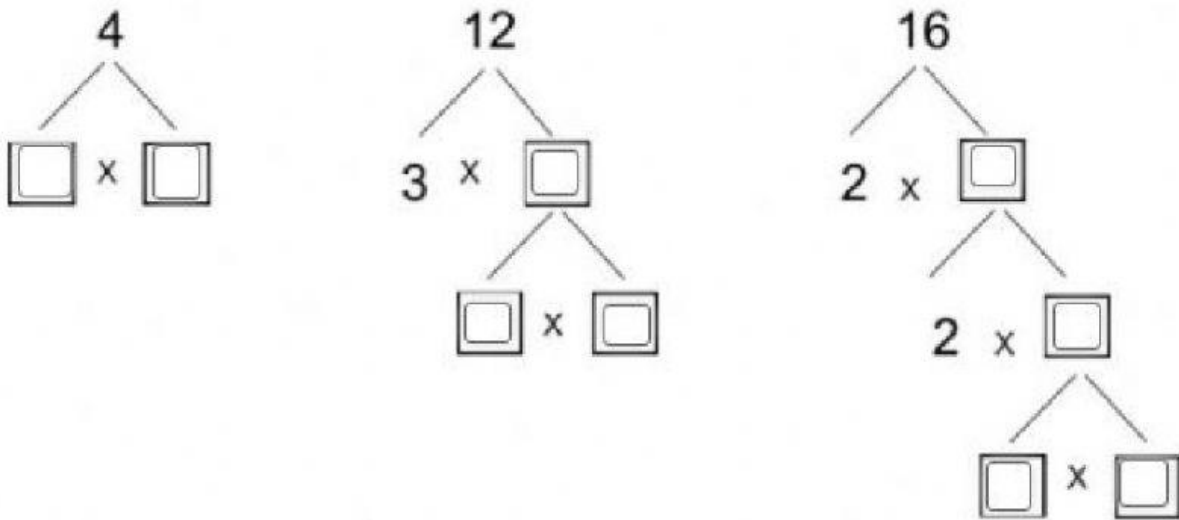


FIND THE GREATEST COMMON FACTOR (GCF) OF 4, 12, 16

STEP 1: COMPLETE THE FACTOR TREE DIAGRAM



STEP 2: LIST THE PRIME FACTORS OF 4, 12, 16

$$\begin{aligned} 4 &= \square \times \square \\ 12 &= \square \times \square \times 3 \\ 16 &= \square \times \square \times 2 \times 2 \end{aligned}$$

STEP 3: FIND THE GREATEST COMMON FACTOR

$$\text{GCF} = \square \times \square = \square$$
