A Van Gogh painting showing a midday scene of the French (39) _____ under a dreary sky has been discovered to be something much more interesting than some researchers have thought before.

Apparently, the original colours of the painting have (40) _____ over time, but while the colour of the sky now is a coffee-like brown, it was originally a bright pink shade which was much more vivid. The (41) _____ that the paint had faded to this degree was made while the painting was being prepared for an art show (42) _____ on the artist's relationship with Britain.
