

Why Is Ancient Greece so Interesting?

It's All Greek to Me!

The Greek civilization was **divided** among an extensive area: on the Balkan Peninsula, on islands in the Mediterranean Sea, and on the coast of Asia Minor. Greece wasn't a unified country because of this division. Since the land was dry and rocky, the Greeks got their food from the Mediterranean. They were **expert sailors** who sailed across the sea to **trade** with other countries.

Each territory had its own government and laws, but they shared the same culture, spoke the same **language**, and worshipped the same gods.

Greek history is divided in three **eras**: Archaic (9th to 6th century BC), Classical (5th to mid-4th century), and Hellenistic (mid-4th to 1st century BC). Before the Ancient Greek civilization there were other civilizations such as the Minoan Crete and the Mycenae.

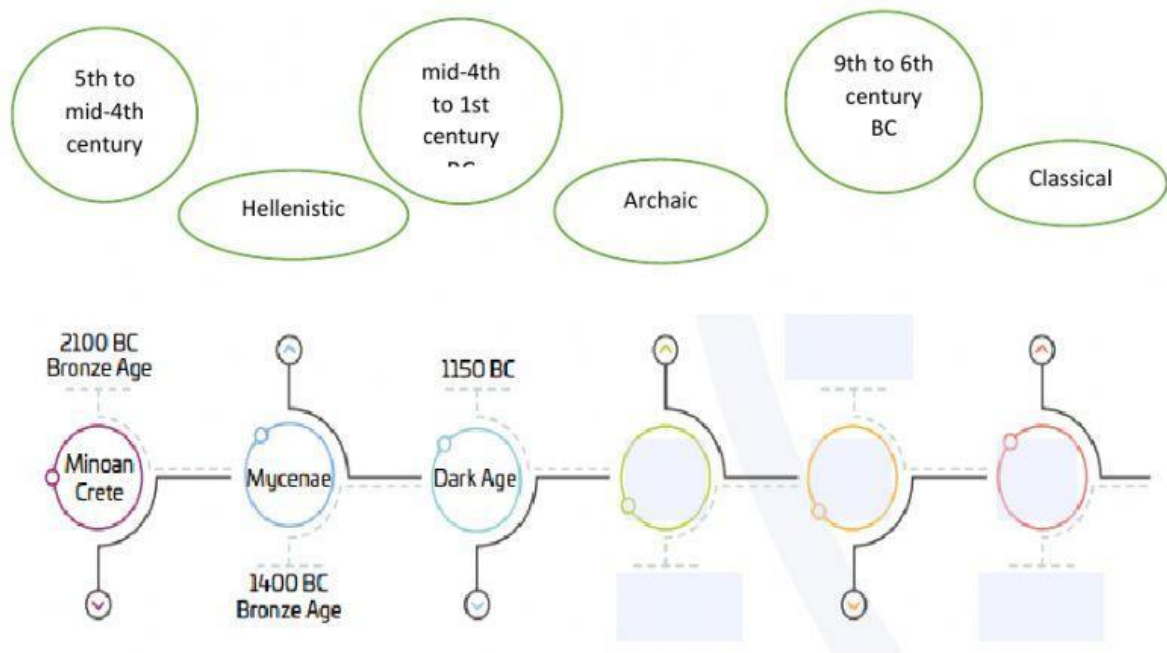
