A boat that people use as their home, often kept in one place on a river or canal.	A set of rooms for living in that are part of a larger building and are usually all on one floor.	It is not connected to any other building.	The main house on a farm where the farmer lives.

			
A large, impressive house.	a type of building that people live in, usually staying in one place, but able to be moved using a vehicle or sometimes its own engine.	A house that is joined to the houses on either side of it by shared walls.	A small house, usually in the countryside. Their roof is made of straw.

		
It is joined to another similar house on only one side.	A house, usually in the countryside or near the sea, especially in southern Europe, and often one that people can rent for a holiday:	a low house having only one storey or, in some cases, upper rooms set in the roof, typically with dormer windows.
