We/You/They **are**

### NEGATIVE

I **am not**  
You **aren't**  
He/She/It **isn't**  
We/You/They **aren't**

### INTERROGATIVE

**Am I?**  
**Are you?**  
**Is he/she/it?**  
**Are we/you/they?**
