


Expressions with clothes:


○ They **don't fit** me anymore / I **don't fit in** it.




○ It is three **sizes too big**.




○ Your top **don't match** very well.



○ **Fitted** jacket




○ **Tight** jeans




○ **Torn/ripped** denim




○ **Loose** pants.




