Peanut Seasoning Cilok

Cilok Material :

- 150gr of sago flour
- 75gr of wheat flour
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp pepper
- 2 cloves of garlic, puree
- Seasonings
- Warm water to taste



Step to Make :

- Mix all ingredients, stir well.
- Add water little by little, until the dough can be formed.
- Prepare the water that is boiling, then form the dough into small rounds and immediately put it into the water.
- If the peel is floating, remove and set aside

Peanut Seasoning Ingredients :

- Peanuts, fry
- 3 cloves of garlic
- 1 red onion
- 2 bird's eye chilies
- 3 red curly chilies
- 2 tbsp brown sugar
- Salt and soy sauce
- Enough water

Step to Make :

- Blend, peanuts, shallots, garlic, bird's eye chilies, curly chilies, and add a little water.
- Heat the pan.
- Put the peanut sauce, brown sugar, soy sauce, salt which has been mashed. Stir until the oil comes out.
- Cilok is ready to be served with peanut sauce.
