A rock guitarist takes a job as a substitute teacher at a private school.

This comedy is about a rock guitarist, Dewey Finn, played by Jack Black. His whole life is about rock music. But he has a problem. He was kicked out of his rock band and he can't pay the rent for his apartment. His roommate, Ned, tells him to get a "real" job but Dewey only wants to find a new rock band.

One day, Dewey accidentally answers a phone call for Ned. It's from a private school. They want Ned to be a substitute teacher for a group of good students. Dewey realizes that the pay is good. He decides to pretend he is Ned and get the job. It's a silly situation because Dewey isn't a teacher and doesn't know what to do in class. Then he discovers that some of these kids are fantastic musicians. He starts a rock band with these kids. Their parents aren't happy at first, but the kids learn teamwork

and become more confident.

This is a movie about how a teacher helps his students through a special way of teaching. It's not a new plot, but the movie is great fun and you'll especially enjoy the music!
