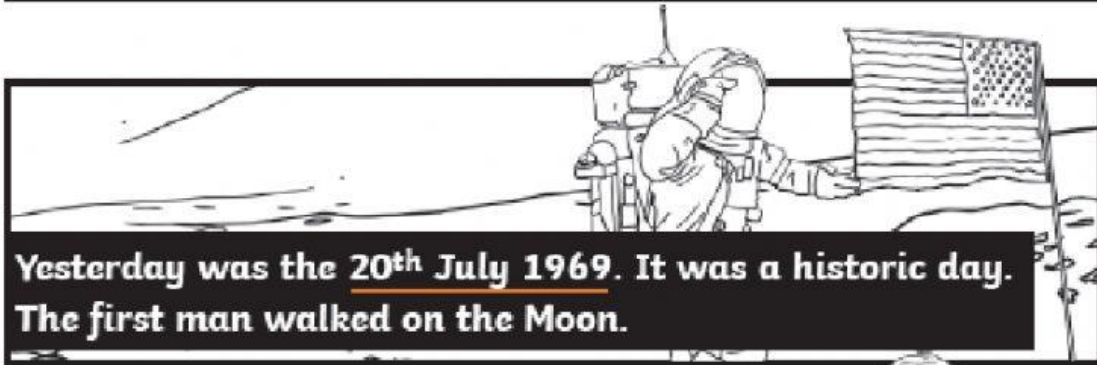


Read the newspaper article below. Answer the questions on the next page.
