

Find the Equivalent fractions (hint: Multiply)

$$1) \quad \frac{2}{3} = \frac{\quad}{6} = \frac{6}{\quad} = \frac{\quad}{12} = \frac{\quad}{15} = \frac{12}{\quad}$$

$$2) \quad \frac{1}{4} = \frac{3}{\quad} = \frac{\quad}{20} = \frac{7}{\quad} = \frac{9}{\quad} = \frac{\quad}{44}$$
