

QUESTION STRUCTURE

There are only 2 simple rules you need to know about how to make questions in English. There are many types of questions, but for the simple ones, these are rules:

1. **There MUST be always an AUXILIARY before the Subject** of the question. (A + S + VERB)

~~You~~ work in San Jose? X

Do you work in San Jose? (correct)

~~I~~ should finish my work at 10? X

Should I finish my work at 10?

Where ~~she~~ lived last year? X

Where did she live?

2. The **verb to be** and true modal verbs (should, may, can, will...etc) are themselves verbs and auxiliary verbs, so you must flip or invert the order as well, **verb to be and modal verbs are placed before the subject in questions:**

~~I~~ can go to the restroom?

Can I go to the restroom?

~~I~~ am right?

Am I right?

~~Ted~~ is hungry?

Is Ted Hungry?

Where ~~Jeff~~ will go?

Where will Jeff go?

~~That~~ is correct?

Is that correct?

Important Hints:

***In the case of verb tenses of continues tenses where the verb to be is the auxiliary, you just flip or invert the verb to be and you put it before the subject (present continuous, past continuous, be going to).

~~you are~~ working?

Are you working?

When ~~the bus is~~ going to arrive?

When is the bus going to arrive?

~~She was~~ working that day?

Was she working that day?

*** the auxiliary of simple present, DOES, already indicates third-person-present, that's why the verb in the question is in simple form, otherwise that is redundant

~~Does Isabella has~~ children?

Does Isabella have children?

*** the auxiliary DID, for simple past, already indicates past time, so, that's why the verb must be in simple form too, because it is considered redundant to use did with a verb in past tense.

~~Did you travelled~~ last month?

Did you travel last month?

~~Did you went~~ to the beach?

Did you go to the beach?
