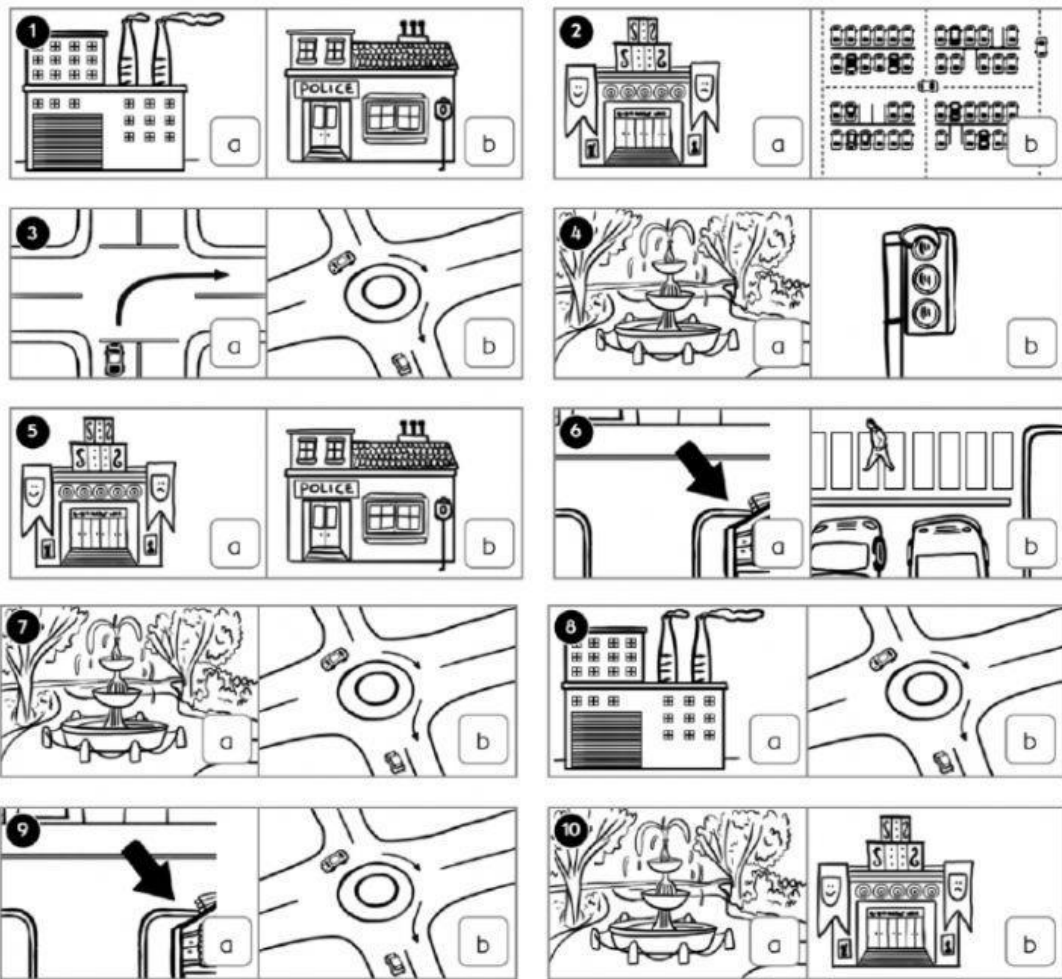

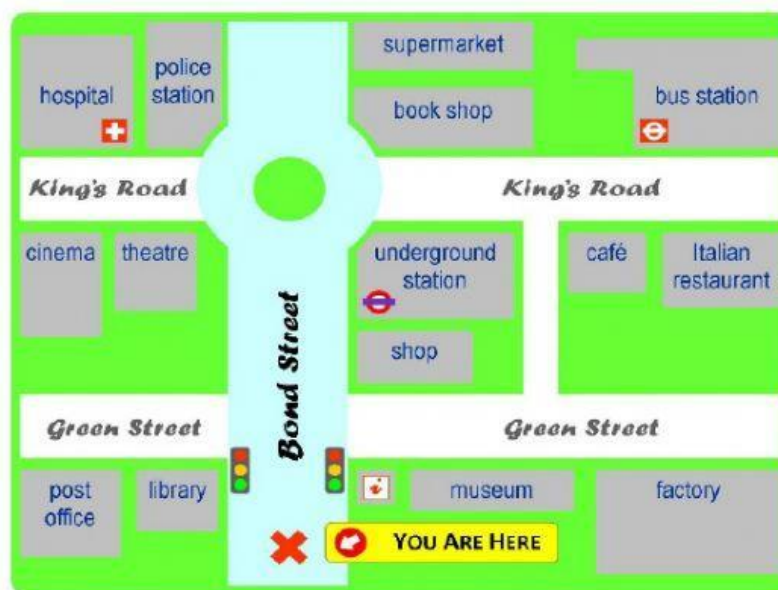
Thanks for your postcard from Egypt.
