

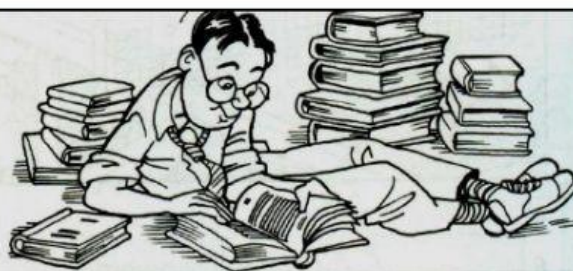

Endangered species around the world

Can you imagine a world without whales, elephants, polar bears, or gorillas?

1 There are about 5,000 endangered animal species. Some scientists believe that at least one species disappears completely every day.

There are many reasons why some animals become endangered species. Most of them are due to human behaviour. Every species needs its own natural place to live, but pollution, farming and building are destroying these areas. Many animals are also sold as pets, or hunted for parts of their bodies such as fur. 2

All kinds of animals from all over the world are in danger. Scientists think that there are only about 600 mountain gorillas left in a very small area. 3 They have lost their natural world, they have been hunted and they have been disturbed by war.

In 1930, there were between 5 and 10 million African elephants. Today there are only about 600,000. 4 Today there are probably no more than 35,000 to 40,000 left in the wild. There are only 300 Yangtze River dolphins and less than 50 Chinese tigers. The Californian condor is one of the world's rarest birds, with only 40 left in captivity.



However, it's not all bad news for endangered species. Conservationists are working hard to change the situation. 5 In 1830, there were 60 million American bison. In 1894, they had been hunted so much that their numbers were less than 100. Thanks to conservation work, there are now about 90,000 American bison! That's a great success!
